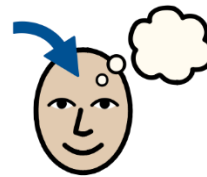

Our Careers team is here to help you make decisions that are **right for you**



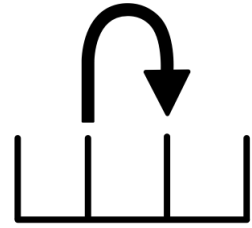

What We Do Together

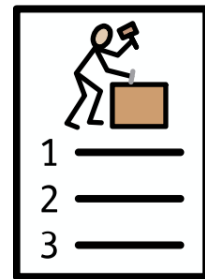
Plan Your Next Steps – Decide what comes after college.

CEIAG gives you **information** and **support** to:

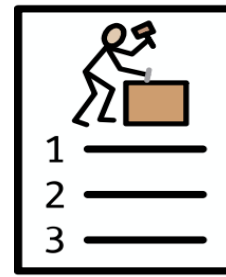
Know your strengths – Things you enjoy and are good at.



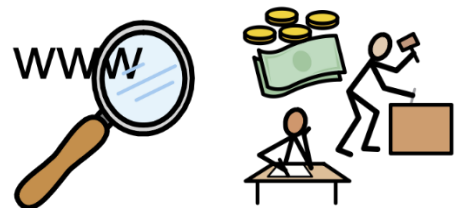
Your CEIAG Space

Talk about Careers – Explore different jobs together.

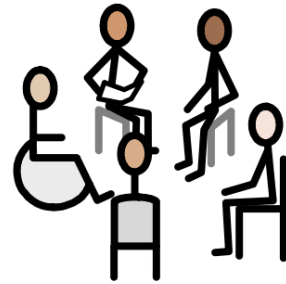


Set Personal Goals – Think about what you're good at and where you want to improve.
