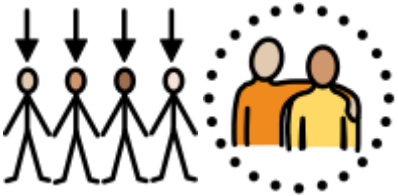
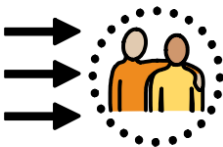
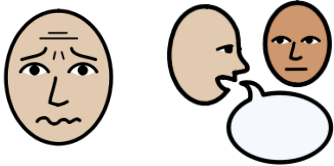
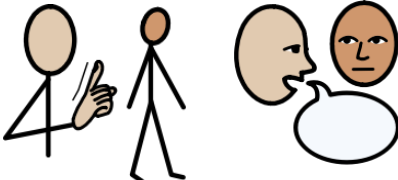
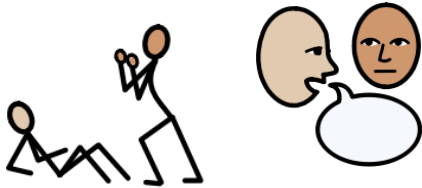
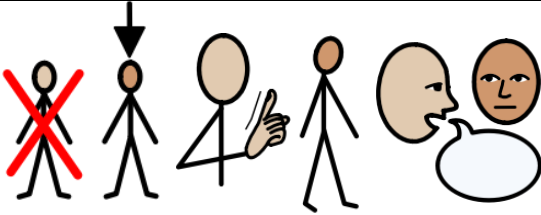
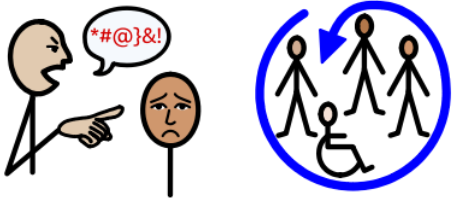
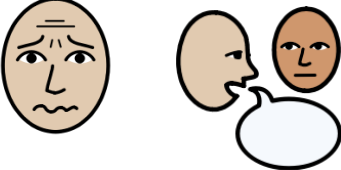
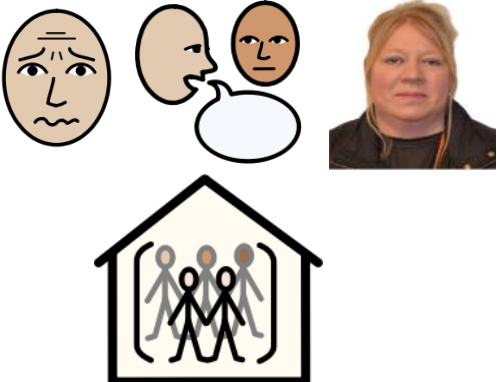


PREVENT

	Staff and trustees at Camphill have a responsibility to make sure that everyone is safe.
	This includes supporting and protecting students who might be at risk of being drawn into terrorist or extreme activity.
	Some people may be more easily influenced by the views of others.
	If you feel uncomfortable about the views of another person then speak to a member of staff.
	If you feel pressured into accepting the views of another person then speak to a member of staff.
	If you are asked to look at material which contains violence or terrorism then speak to a member of staff.

	If you think that someone else is being pressured by an individual into accepting their views then speak to a member of staff.
	At college you will have sessions which look at topics which include bullying, diversity and British Values.
	It is important to accept that people have different views and opinions and religions.
	If you feel uncomfortable you should speak to someone.
	The staff member in college who leads on Prevent is Helen.
	If you have any worries or concerns you can speak to Helen or another trusted member of staff.
