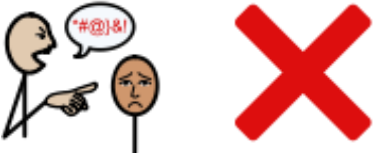
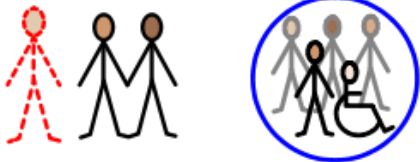
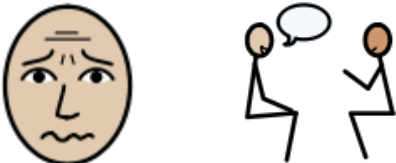
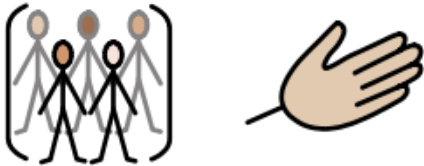
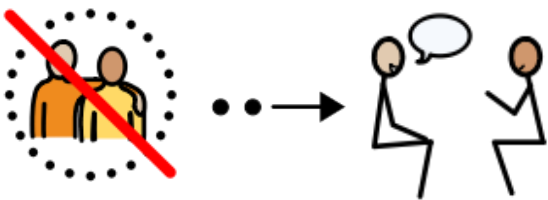


SAFEGUARDING POLICY
